CASE STUDY

KINGS CROSS SQUARE, LONDON

This award-winning project from 2015 is not only aesthetically impressive, but reduced energy consumption with long life LEDs.



In the redevelopment of King's Cross Square, the station's new entrance, StudioFRACTAL were commissioned to create a new lighting scheme.

REQUIREMENT

The project is the first large scale public realm project in the UK to use only LED technology and Kemps were specified to provide both standard and bespoke LED luminaires for the project.

Kemps were also specified to provide luminaires for the newly improved, low energy LED lighting for the famous clock at the top of the building's façade.
